

Pool Rules

For the safety and enjoyment of all residents and guests, both the Knox County health and safety regulations and Saddle Ridge rules must be followed.

As no pool monitors/lifeguards are present, it is the duty of each homeowner/family member/guest to follow and/or enforce all pool rules. Anyone observed in violation of the pool rules is to be reported to the on-call pool representative (1st) and /or the SRHA Pool board member (2nd) immediately and directed to leave the pool area. Further action will be determined following the “two strike protocol”- see #21.

The SRHA and its board members are not responsible for any accident, injury, or illness in connection with the use of the SR pool. All persons using the SR pool do so at their own risk.

SRHA POOL HOURS OF OPERATION

6am - 9am Lap swim only

9am - 9pm General swim (Sun-Thurs)

9am -10pm General swim (Fri-Sat)

Note: Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or sibling of at least 16 years of age or older at all times.

Note: The SR pool, clubhouse, tennis courts and parking lot are under 24/7 video surveillance and monitoring for SR residents protection, protection of SRHA property and will be used to prove inappropriate behavior or illegal activity. The SRHA video surveillance and

monitoring of the pool is NOT for the safety of swimmers and should not be considered a replacement for appropriate adult supervision and behavior. Those that choose to use any SRHA amenities do so at their own risk. SRHA and its board are not responsible for injuries, loss and or damage while using any SHRA amenities.

1. Clubhouse rentals do not include Pool Parties.
2. All children under 12 years old MUST be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or sibling of at least 16 years of age or older at all times.
3. SR residents in good standing and their guests are allowed use of the pool. Friends of guests are not allowed. The number of guests a single SR household can bring to the pool at one time is limited to 5. SR residents are responsible for their guest's activities and behavior.
4. Diving, rough play, fighting, pushing or running is prohibited inside the fenced SR pool area.
5. Larger/older children are encouraged to use the deeper end of the SR pool when small children are present.
6. Consumption of food and beverages is permitted on the pool decking area, however food and beverages (including alcohol) must remain at least 5 feet from the pool at all times. This is a public health requirement for the safety of all using the SR pool.
7. Use of glass containers is strictly prohibited as a public health requirement. Gum, tobacco, vapes, alcohol (see #8), profanity, illegal acts or any inappropriate behavior is also prohibited inside the fenced SR pool area.
8. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by adults 21 years of age and older in plastic, can, or paper containers ONLY (no glass) is permitted on the pool decking area during the following days and hours:

Monday through Sunday 5pm to 10pm ONLY, NO EXCEPTIONS.

9. Single person rafts or single person flotation devices may be used if there is adequate space.

10. NO hard balls, footballs or basketballs are allowed inside the SR pool fenced area.

11. Rollerblades, skateboards, bikes, tricycles, scooters, e-bikes and pets are NOT permitted inside the SR pool fenced area, clubhouse or the tennis courts.

12. No one with open sores or infections shall be allowed in the SR pool. This is a public health requirement for the safety of all using the pool.

13. The Association, if required by County or State, health directives or mandates, may close the pool or allow its use with additional restrictions and of conditions use.

14. Children in diapers are not allowed into the SR pool unless they are wearing a swim diaper or plastic swim pants. This is a public health requirement for the safety of all using the pool.

15. It is every SRHA member's responsibility to properly dispose of all litter in the garbage cans. If you brought it with you, dispose of it in the garbage cans provided by SRHA. Be sure to remove all children's toys from the SR pool and decking area before you leave. Do not dispose of household trash in the SRHA garbage cans, they are intended for waste generated from activities at the pool, tennis courts, and clubhouse only.

16. Unauthorized entrance into the SR pool before or after stated days and hours of operation or during shutdown periods is prohibited and is grounds for suspension of SR pool privileges.

17. A key to the pool and tennis courts is issued to each homeowner upon moving into SR subdivision.

Duplication of keys is prohibited. Duplication or lending of keys to non SR residents or giving the SR pool key to under age swimmers not accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or sibling of 16 years of age or older is grounds for suspension of SR tennis courts and pool privileges. 18. Bathing attire is required at the SR pool. For safety reasons, T-shirts may not be worn.

19. Audio equip must be kept at a reasonable volume. Any noise or music that actively disturbs fellow residents is strictly prohibited.

20. Proper standards of behavior and decorum are expected. SRHA members are expected to be self- policing. Parents, legal guardians or siblings of at least 16 years of age MUST supervise the children and guests in their care. Deviation or violation of the rules of conduct will be reported to the SRHA board.

21. Gross misbehavior at the SRHA pool will be handled with the use of a Two Strikes Protocol. A strike results when there is repeated or blatant disregard of the pool rules or any SRHA rules. The SR resident/homeowner will be contacted for the first incident to inform them of the situation, allowing the SR resident the opportunity to address the issue. The SRHA pool committee board member will contact the SR resident homeowner upon the second strike and inform them the violator will be prohibited from use of the SR pool for the rest of the season.

22. SR home owner association dues must be current in order to use the pool facility.

23. The SRHA and its board will NOT be liable for personal injury, loss and or personal property damage incurred while using the SR pool.

24. All SRHA members have the responsibility for enforcement of all SRHA rules.
